The Requirement

Headline have a long standing relationship with TSL and so were delighted to be invited to join the project team in implementing a new advertising system, incorporating a customer relationship management programme.

The requirement from Headline was to design a range of instructor-led courses to encompass the functionality of the new system in conjunction with business processes; and to deliver the end-user training to all teams including, classified, display, exhibitions, prime & production.

The Approach

Working side-by-side with the TSL SOP project team, Headline drew on their experience of newspaper systems and their existing knowledge of Media Systems Ltd (MSL) Adtaker Advertising system, to get off to a head start in understanding the new developments to the system required for the TSL implementation. Headline examined the workflows of individual teams to produce training materials relevant to their needs. Our aim was to produce a set of "quick reference" handout sheets for each type of booking, integrating elements of the new business processes. Additionally we created tailored Training plans for each team and role, detailing the course content and structure. These training plans ensure that consistent training is delivered out at all times either by Headline or TSL trainers.

During this planning phase, Headline was able to emulate a user's approach to the system and thus suggest appropriate elements of software configuration and development. Dedicated training

databases were populated with meaningful data to ensure that training scenarios provided an experience of 'reality'.

The Delivery

Headline delivered tailored end-user training in both half-day training sessions and one-day training sessions. Each delegate received quick reference guides to remind them how to complete each type of booking as well as keyboard shortcuts and booking schemes. Exercises were created to support the training and to give users real examples to practice with before go-live.

During volume tests, parallel runs and 'go-live week' Headline provided support resources to assist with the smooth transition to the new system.
